

Loudon County Sheriff's Office Citizen's Academy

Sheriff Jimmy Davis and the Loudon County Sheriff's Office host their Citizen's Law Enforcement Academy for Loudon County residents each Spring and Fall. The series of classes is free of charge and taught by law enforcement professionals volunteering their time to share their expertise. Class openings are limited and will require a background check. Upon successful completion, graduates will receive a certificate of completion at a graduation ceremony.

PURPOSE

The academy's purpose is to provide citizens with a basic understanding of the training and requirements for local law enforcement officers and to foster a cooperative partnership between citizens and the deputies who serve them.

- Detention Center Operations (Jail Tour)
- K9 Operations and Capabilities
- Patrol Fleet Operations
- Patrol Ride-a-Long
